Waterpark Rules

Waterpark Rules (Please observe all posted hours of operation.)

- No one with a fever or symptoms of COVID 19, or known exposure to a COVID 19 case in the prior 14 days, is
 permitted to enter the pool facility or beach swimming area. Use of the pool facility and beach swimming
 area involves exposure to other people and the inherent risk of contracting COVID 19. By enter the pool facility or beach swimming area, you assume this risk of contracting COVID 19 for yourself and for your minor
 children.
- All swimmers are required to take showers before entering any pools.
- The use of profanity is strictly prohibited.
- Running, pushing, dunking, and horseplay are strictly prohibited.
- Diving, back dives, and flips are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages, smoking, candy, gum, and glass containers are prohibited.
- Food and drink in non-glass containers are only permitted in the lounging and table areas.
- All animals with the exception of guide animals for the handicapped shall be prohibited within the pool fence.
- Guests with skin disease(s), open wounds, bandages, feminine hygiene napkins, nasal or ear discharge, inflamed eyes, cough, cold, fever, blisters, diapers or any communicable disease are not allowed in the pool.
- Spitting, urinating, blowing of the nose, spouting of water or depositing foreign matter in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- Infants must wear swim diapers, regular diapers are prohibited.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian.
- Lifeguards are not baby-sitters. Adults must be in proper bathing suit attire and are not allowed to supervise from the pool deck. (Directly supervised within arms reach.) Four (4) youth (ages 5 and under) may be supervised by one adult age 18 or older in the same pool.
- Guests between ages 6 thru 12 must take a swim test. If they pass, they may swim without direct supervision. Guests ages 5 and under must be directly supervised in the water in the same area of the pool by an adult age 18 or older.
- Use of swimming accessories and flotation devices shall be regulated by lifeguards. Pool toys and floats will not be allowed when the pool is crowded.
- Children in flotation devices shall be supervised by an adult age 18 or older. (Directly supervised within arms reach.)
- Never swim when thunder and/or lightning are present.
- These rules are for everyone's safety and enjoyment and we appreciate your cooperation.
- Failure to abide by these rules may result in injury to yourself or others and could result in removal from the waterpark or the resort.
- Lifeguards have the authority to enforce all pool rules and evict anyone not abiding by the pool rules. These rules are for the safety of everyone and we ask for everyone's cooperation.

Waterslide Rules (Please observe all posted hours of operation.)

- You must be 48" tall to ride, and have passed the swim test.
- Strong swimming ability required.
- Non-swimmers and those over 275 lbs. not permitted.
- Riders shall follow directions from the lifeguard.
- Loose items such as hats or visors are not permitted, eyeglasses must be secured.
- Life jackets or other flotation devices are prohibited other than those designed for the slide and used as directed by the manufacturer.
- Riders must remain flat and feet first at all times. Stopping, changing positions, and forming "chains" are not permitted.
- Slides are recommended for guests in good health and good physical condition.
- Pregnant women, guests with heart conditions, guests with neck, back, or bone/joint problems, high blood
 pressure, those having experienced a recent illness or surgery, and/or guests under the influence of alcohol
 or drugs are not permitted to ride.
- Riders must exit the splash pool immediately upon entry.
- Failure to abide by these rules may result in injury to yourself and others and could result in removal from the waterpark or the resort.

Waterpark Rules (continued)

Swim Test

Guests ages six (6) through twelve (12) are required to pass a swim test. If they pass, they may swim without direct supervision. Guests passing the swim test will be issued a wristband from the lifeguard.

- All skills are unassisted. Swim the length of the family pool with a reasonably good stroke without stopping. Tread
 water for two minutes and float on your back for three minutes. If the guest grabs the wall or touches the bottom of
 the pool, the guest will not pass the test.
- One test per day per guest.
- After passing the test, the lifeguard will issue a wristband to be worn at all times when in the swimming pool area.
- Guests must wear the provided wristband in order to swim without direct supervision. If the guest looses or does not bring the wristband another swim test will be required.

Beach Swimming Area Rules (Please observe all posted hours of operation.)

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- Swim in designated area only. Never swim alone.
- Running, pushing, dunking, horseplay and the use of profanity are strictly prohibited.
- Diving, back dives, and flips are prohibited. Never swim while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian.
- Children in flotation devices shall be supervised by an adult 18 or older (directly supervised within arms reach).
- All animals with the exception of guide animals for the handicapped shall be prohibited on the beach or in the swimming area.
- Glassware is not permitted on the beach or in the swimming area. Please return beach furniture to proper locations after use.
- Diving from the dock, gazebo or shoreline is prohibited. Climbing or sitting on dock railings is prohibited.
- Do not swim in poor weather conditions, during a storm or when lightning is present. If poor weather conditions arise, vacate the swimming area and seek shelter.
- Failure to abide by these rules may result in injury to yourself and others and could result in removal from the resort.
- NO LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY AT THE LAKE. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

These rules are for the safety and enjoyment of everyone and we ask for everyone's cooperation.

Beach, Snack Bar attendants and all other staff of Bethpage Camp-Resort have the authority to enforce all rules and evict anyone not abiding by the rules.
